SPREE's Excursion Series videos have been developed for the sole distribution to schools that had signed up for a field trip this spring. While we can't replicate a SPREE trip experience, we hope your students will enjoy the video!

Activity: River, Lake, Pond (Simon Says)

Define the three different bodies of water & teach students their related hand movements. *Can be played virtually!*

River – a body of water that has land on two sides. The water in a river flows (moves). Hand movement – raise one arm parallel to the ground and move it in a wave pattern

Lake – a body of water that has land all the way around it. It is usually too large for people to see across it. Hand movement – bring both arms out in front of you to form a large circle

Pond – A pond is like a smaller lake. It has land all the way around it but is easy to see across. People are usually able to walk all the way around a pond. Hand movement – use both hands to form a small circle in front of you

Play a game of "Simon Says" with students, using the river, lake, and pond hand motions.

Worksheet: Complete the Mallard Duck

After students have viewed the duck dress-up video, give them one of the two worksheets to complete. One has the three items (webbed feet, bill, feathers) missing for students to draw in themselves, and the other has the three items removed for them to match to where they go on the duck.
